

Historical Note

The Daughters of Charity of the United States and their service in World War II included service as nurses in the Pacific theater in the interior of China with American service members. They also were highly involved in raising funds and supplies for refugee funds and to rebuild Europe in the aftermath of the war, particularly with the War Relief Services of the National Catholic Welfare Conference.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains correspondence and updates from Sister Madeleine Morris, a Daughter of Charity from the United States missioned to the Motherhouse of the community in Paris during the entirety of World War II and the immediate aftermath of the War. It also contains general information about the Daughters of Charity and the Vincentian priests, information about war relief and the War Relief Service of the National Catholic Welfare Conference, information on Daughters of Charity serving as nurses with American servicemen in the interior of China, photographs, artifacts, newspaper clippings, and secondary articles about the Daughters of Charity and the War.
